Further to your question in Plenary on 5 June 2013, I can further confirm that the Superfast Cymru roll-out in the Caerphilly borough will be underway this financial year and completed by 2016.

The Welsh Government is committed to ensuring that both homes and businesses across Wales have access to next generation broadband by 2016. The Welsh Government and BT are working in partnership through the Superfast Cymru programme to bring the benefits of fast fibre broadband to those areas outside the planned commercial footprint in Wales.
